cross the Inland Sea to Miyajima Island, where we'll visit Itsukushima shrine, a giant torii gate, which at high tide seems to float on the water.

We leave Miyajima Island for Hiroshima, a modern and prosperous city that will be forever remembered as the world's first atomic bomb target. We'll experience the famous Hiroshima tram, and visit Hiroshima Peace Park and Peace Museum, one of the most prominent features of the city. The trees, lawns and walking paths are in stark contrast to the surrounding downtown area.

We'll then catch the Bullet train back to Okayama.

Day 7 Sunday 8th April

KANAZAWA

After breakfast, we check out of the hotel and walk to the station to catch the Bullet Train for Kyoto, then connect with the train for Kanazawa. Purchase a picnic lunch at Okayama station to enjoy on the train so that we can start our sightseeing tour from Kanazawa station.

Upon arrival into Kanazawa we'll be taken on a sightseeing tour exploring the old district of Higashiyama; a Geisha house; Kutani pottery workshop where you can see a demonstration by a master potter; the former samurai residential area; plus one of Japan's most famous gardens, Kenrokuen garden.
